

Ice Cube Fishing

Ingredients:

- Cup of Ice
- Piece of Cotton String
- Table Salt

Directions:

- 1. Fill a cup with ice
- 2. Bury string in ice/cup, leaving small piece sticking out at the top
- 3. Sprinkle salt over ice cubes & string
- 4. Count to 20
- 5. Lift your string

The Science Behind It:

Salt lowers the freezing point of water; therefore, the ice began to melt. As the ice melted it became colder and the string froze to the ice.
